Gaylord National Resort in National Harbor

Attendees who arrive before Noon on Thursday, or guests who have the time on Friday and Saturday, have many options available to them to tour DC and the surrounding area. The Water Taxis from the National Harbor offer routes connecting to Old Town Alexandria and The Wharf. Alternatively, visit the MGM National Harbor for table games and slot machines. Local tours, booked at the Gaylord Concierge Desk include an Old Town Trolley Tour and a Monuments by Moonlight Tour.

All Aboard! Water Taxis

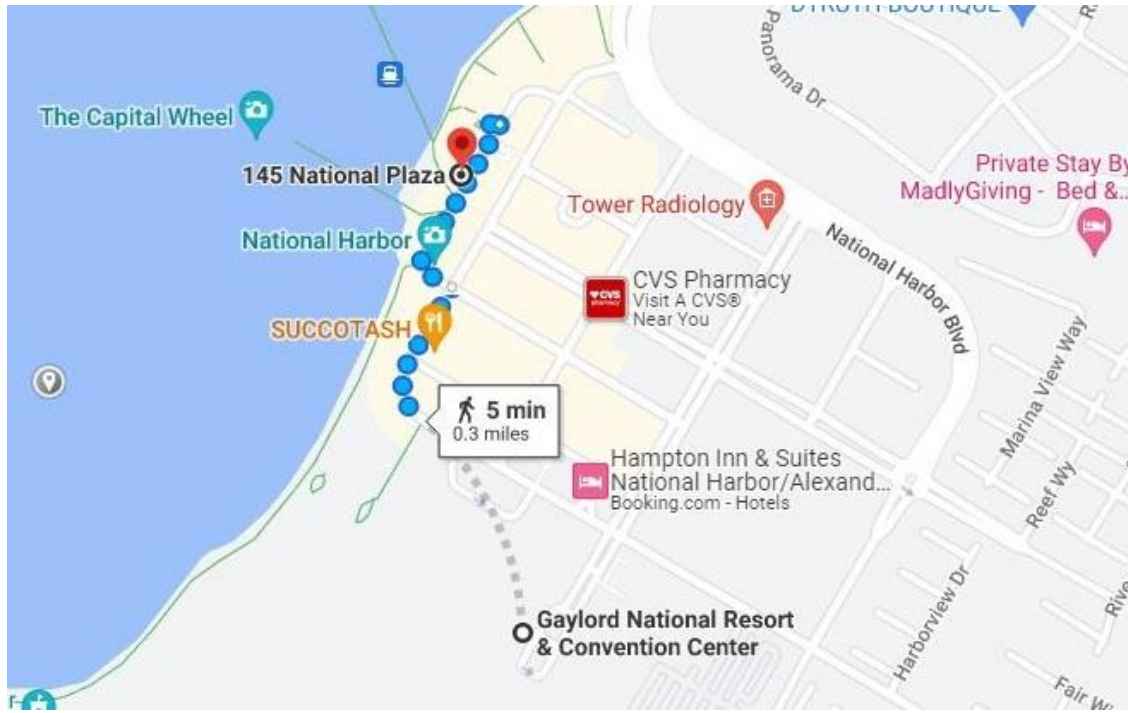

Local Tours (Booked at the Gaylord Resort Concierge Desk)

Gaylord National Resort partners with Old Town Trolley to provide shuttle service to downtown Washington, D.C. and tours of the Capital region. Tickets for all tours can be purchased at the concierge desk at Gaylord National. All tours depart from *The Welcome Center* in downtown Washington, D.C., except the Monuments by Moonlight tour. Ask the concierge desk for more information.

Old Town Trolley Tours (Day Tour)

Named "Washington's Best Tour" by the Washingtonian Magazine, the Old Town Trolley offers the most comprehensive tour of the Nation's Capital. This tour highlights the region's most iconic attractions including the Lincoln Memorial, the White House, the Smithsonian Museums, Vietnam Veterans' Memorial and Arlington National Cemetery. All tours are conducted in a trolley and led by licensed and professional tour guides.

All day hop on and off Old Town Trolley Tours of Downtown and Arlington Cemetery \$39.95 per adult, \$29.95 per child ages 4-12 years old. Runs 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM.

Monuments by Moonlight Tour

Enjoy the sights and sounds of Washington, D.C.'s iconic monuments by night. The tour includes the Capitol Building, the White House and the Washington Monument and makes stops at the Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial/ FDR Memorial, the Lincoln Memorial and the Jefferson Memorial. The Lincoln Memorial stop includes the Vietnam Veteran's Memorial and the Korean War Veteran's Memorial.

Monuments by Moonlight tour \$42 per adult, \$32 per child ages 4-12 with a courtesy pick up at the Gaylord National Resort at 6:30 pm. Tour begins at 7:30 PM. Reservations required.
